

# Gregg Riddle Memorial Scholarship

PCS believes, as did Gregg, that there are individual members of both organizations who would benefit from the exposure gained by attending the Annual Illinois IPSTA 9-1-1 Conference. The GRMS is intended to facilitate that attendance.

## **GRMS Application and Award Process:**

PCS suggests that the GRMS be awarded to two members of IL APCO and/or IL NENA who have an active public safety membership category with either of the two associations. The GRMS is awarded to the applicants that submit applications with the best justification supporting the GRMS award.
